Scholarship Program

The Portland Chapter of the Institute of Management Accountants has established a scholarship program which more effectively directs scholarship funds towards encouraging new IMA membership and CMA professional growth. The following criterion identifies those individuals interested in CMA programs and offsets some of their costs of obtaining certification:

- New regular or student members may apply for a \$200 scholarship if they agree to
 - Enroll as a new IMA regular or student member and affiliate with the Portland Chapter and
 - Enroll in an IMA-endorsed CMA study program.
- All IMA Portland Chapters members may apply for a \$100 reimbursement for each:
 - Completion of an IMA-endorsed CMA study program.
 - Each CMA exam part passed.
- Annual limit of \$500 per individual, per year.
- Lifetime limit of \$1,000 per individual.
- Repeat enrollments in one of the four-part study programs are not eligible.
- If an individual drops out of a CMA study program and receives a refund, the individual will share the refund with the IMA Portland Chapter prorated according to the IMA Portland Chapter portion and the individual's portion.
