- Develop corporate level P&L models and works with business units across Fiserv to ensure targets are met. Provide guidance to program owners and executives on program performance
- Develops complex financial database programs to generate P&L's

- Performs monthly close and forecast process and prepares monthly operational reports and financial tracking of projects across Fiserv
